

# District of Columbia February 2023 Bar Exam Announcement

## Applicants are responsible for all information contained in this Announcement. Please read carefully.

#### **General Information**

The February 2023 Uniform Bar Exam will be administered by the District of Columbia Court of Appeals ("DCCA") *in person*, on February 21-22, 2023. The exam materials are on paper. Laptops are required to write responses for the essay portions of the exam. Applicants who wish to handwrite their essays must submit a request to Director Shanks, at <a href="mailto:sshanks@dcappeals.gov">sshanks@dcappeals.gov</a>. Responses for the multiple choice sections of the exam will be recorded on scantron sheets with No. 2 pencils.

The standard administration of the exam will consist of four 3-hour sessions with a 45-60 minute break midday on each day. Applicants who wish to request variances from the standard administration of the exam must apply for ADA accommodations. Applicants who are nursing may request non-ADA accommodations. (See "Accommodations" below.) Applicants granted ADA accommodations *may* test additional days. (See "Schedules" below.)

The standard administration of the exam will take place at the <u>D.C. Armory</u> located at 2001 East Capitol Street, SE.

Applicants are responsible for monitoring your email and the <u>Committee on Admissions website</u> for updates to exam information throughout the exam period.

#### **COVID 19 Protocols**

The DCCA is closely monitoring health and safety mandates, and recommendations issued by federal and local authorities concerning COVID 19. DCCA recognizes that conditions and protocols may change between now and the time of the exam and will make appropriate modifications to exam procedures as required and recommended by public health authorities. Depending on the status of the COVID 19 pandemic, applicants may be required to wear a mask fully covering their mouth and nose during the exam. All COVID-19 safety and health procedures will be announced closer to the exam.

#### **Exam Registration/Application**

Registration for the exam will open on November 1, 2022 at 9:00am ET and will close on November 30, 2022 at 11:59pm ET. There is NO late registration period. If you wish to sit for the exam, you must submit your application by November 30, 2022 at 11:59pm. It is recommended that you do not wait until the last minute to submit your application in the event that you encounter technical difficulties and are unable to submit your application by the deadline.

Applicants can create an account on the Committee on Admissions website at: <u>DC Bar Admissions Home</u> (<u>dcappeals.gov</u>) by selecting the "Create Account" button at the bottom of the page, **however the** application for the FEBRUARY exam will not open until November 1<sup>st</sup>. Please do not attempt to begin an application until November 1st. Applicants can browse a copy of the application on the website at <u>DC Bar Admissions Browse Forms</u> (<u>dcappeals.gov</u>).

Please read all instructions. Do not rely upon past instructions, or instructions for other jurisdictions.

#### **Accommodations**

Applicants wishing to apply for accommodations can submit accommodations requests beginning today, October 21, 2022 through November 30, 2022, by sending the <u>request form</u> and supporting medical documentation to <u>dcaccommodations@dcappeals.gov</u>. All applicants, including applicants who have previously been granted accommodations for a D.C. bar exam must submit a request form with supporting documentation. Please read the <u>guidelines</u> for documentation in support of your request. A copy of your request and supplemental documentation must also be uploaded with your application when you register for the exam.

Applicants who breastfeeding and wish to apply for a courtesy accommodation can do so by submitting a letter with medical documentation as proof that they are nursing by submitting a request to Director Shanks at <a href="mailto:sshanks@dcappeals.gov">sshanks@dcappeals.gov</a>. Individuals who are breastfeeding and who wish to request an ADA accommodation should send their request to: <a href="mailto:dcaccommodations@dcappeals.gov">dcaccommodations@dcappeals.gov</a>.

Emergency Accommodations *may* be granted where an applicant experiences circumstances that create a need for accommodations *after* the deadline. For Emergency Accommodations send an email with details and supporting documentation to Director Shanks at: <a href="mailto:sshanks@dcappeals.gov">sshanks@dcappeals.gov</a>.

Appeals can be made up to ten days after an accommodation grant is denied in full or in part. Appeals must contain new information with supporting documentation Appeals may not include new or additional requests that were not a part of the original accommodation request.

#### **Laptop Registration**

Applicants must pay the software licensing fee of \$150 and register their laptops directly with the software vendor, ILG360. Laptop registration will open January 19<sup>th</sup> and end January 30<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Exam Schedules**

The standard exam test sites will open at 8:00 am. The exam will begin at 9:00am. Applicants who are late to any session of the exam will not be admitted to the exam. The general schedules for the standard and non-standard administrations of the exam are shown beginning on the next page.
